

Japanese born pianist, **Yuki Mack** has performed throughout the United States, Europe and Asia, including Gilmore International Piano Festival in Michigan, Great Lakes Chamber Music Festival in Michigan, Chamber Music Society of Detroit in Michigan, International Maskfest Festival in San Marino, Intun International Music Festival in Italy, International Forest Festival in Czech Republic, Quebec International Music Festival in Canada, to name some. Together they were awarded prizes in several national and international competitions. They also recorded several highly acclaimed collection of four-hands piano music albums exhibit their unique sense of interpretation and flawless technique. She has also established herself as a highly sought after educator and in 2021 she was awarded as “Best teacher of the year” by Steinway & Sons.
